Gayletta owns and operates *Gayletta's Photographic Studio & Gallery* located in Nederland, Texas -- the same town where she grew up and went to high school. *Gayletta* is a member of Professional Photographers Guild of Houston, Guild of Southeast Texas, Texas Professional Photographers, and the Professional Photographers of America. *Gayletta* received the "Distinguished Print Award" from the Southwest Photographers Association in 1996 and in a "Loan Print" in 1999. In 1998, she received her Photographic Craftsman degree from the PPA. In 2000 she earned her PPA Certification, and in 2004, she earned her Master of Photography.

Gayletta published her first book, "Visions of Love", and opened an exhibit featuring relationship portraiture in 2005 as a celebration of her earning her Master of Photography degree.
